Thankfully it has been a quiet July in PRE. Thus I have no substantive news to pass on in this Update. The County has finally approved a contract for our engineer to complete specs for the paving project, which will enable it to be put out for contractors' bids. When they have an estimated paving date, the Paving Task Force will distribute detailed information about when and how paving will take place and needed road management during that time. In addition, many of you are hard at work on your defensible space, which is a service to us all – thank you so very much!

One related reminder: there is a <u>Measure C-funded Free Curbside Chipper Day Program this year</u>.
